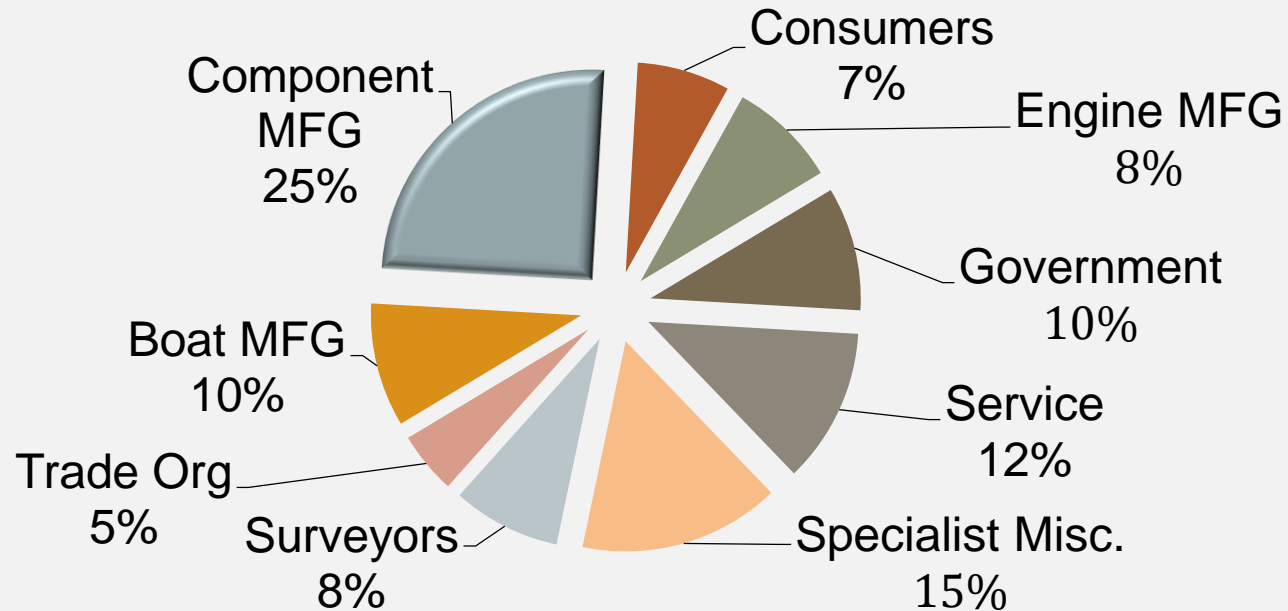
# ABYC Standards Certification Course
